## APES Grade Policy

The total number of points available to a student is based on their effort. The minimum total points a student must earn will be out of 200 (Exam and Lab) All other points serve to increase the total points available, therefore decreasing the impact of single point, creating a larger margin for error on exams and labs. For Example:
Student A gets an 87 on their exam and a 78 on their lab and doesn't complete any more assignments. Their average score will be $(87+78) / 200=82.5 \%$ a B-

Student B gets the exact same exam and lab scores but completes all of their study slides (100 points) and does 5 Podcast Connections ( 50 points). So now the total points available is Exam (100)+Lab(100)+Study Slides(100) + Podcast Connections (50) $=350$ total points This students score will be $(87+78+100+50) / 350=90 \%$ an A -
